
Please note: in order to install this bracket, you will need access inside your kayak to be able to tighten the bracket screws that will go through the surface of the kayak. Consider where you wish to attach the bracket with this in mind and also for ease of use when using the kayak itself and access operating the motor.


Step 1

Ensure the central nut is fitted firmly inside of the pocket underneath the base.




Step 2

Place the base on your kayak where you wish to position the bracket and mark pilot holes. Carefully drill pilot hole. Attach bracket base to your kayak using the bolts, washers and nuts provided. Remember to put the base cushions between the kayak body and the base of the bracket as shown below.




Step 4

Assemble the two swivel clamps as shown. Do not tighten the bolts completely at this stage but tighten them enough to hold the parts in place. Once assembled, your unit should resemble the inset Diagram 1 below.



Step 3

Place the inclined plate on the base as shown and screw the provided bolt into place. Do not fully tighten the bolt at this stage just tighten it enough to hold the parts in place.



Screw together the Jack body and then screw on the jack beam as shown using




Step 6

Assemble the steer locker body as shown.



Step 7


Assemble the depth adjustment clamp and the steer handle as shown.



Step 8


Remove the motor unit's head, but make sure you note the wiring connections before disconnecting, or take a photo as you will need to reconnect these wires back. Then remove the existing motor bracket. Once you have just the shaft with wires poking from the top, slide on the jack body, steer locker body, and depth adjustment clamp onto the motor shaft.

Step 9

Re-attach the motor head and tighten all screws on the bracket.


